The committee, which is appointed by the Board of Directors, has engaged the services of Fortner, Bayens, Levkulich & Garrison, P.C., which specializes in internal audits of credit unions to ensure all aspects of the credit union are protected. The National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) our federal regulatory agency, performs a safety and soundness examination regularly on NuVista to verify the credit union is complying with federal regulations. The Supervisory Committee also follows an annual work plan for additional review of board actions, controls, policies and procedures on behalf of our members. Based on the results of our internal audit procedures, the NCUA'S examination report and the oversight of the Supervisory Committee, it is the opinion of the Supervisory Committee that NuVista continues to be financially sound and well managed, The Supervisory Committee serves as your voice in NuVista's affairs.
