#### What You Can do to Help Protect Your Privacy:

Protect your account numbers, card numbers, social security numbers, PINs (personal identification numbers), and passwords. In particular, never keep your PIN with your debit or credit card, as that makes you vulnerable in the event you lose your card or the card is stolen.

Use Caution in revealing account numbers, social security numbers, etc. to other persons. If a caller tells you he/she is calling you on behalf of the credit union and asks for your account number, you should beware. Legitimate credit union staff would already have access to that information. It's important that you keep your information current with NuVista. If we detect potentially fraudulent use of your account, we will attempt to contact you immediately. If your address, phone number or email changes, please let us know.
